What is the role?

We need you to help maintain and improve the Council's parks and open spaces within the borough. Your main role will be driving a tractor to maintain the Council's award winning Town Centre parks and gardens.

You will:

- Allocate and direct the work of a small team of gardeners or volunteers
- Prepare sites and construct hard and soft landscaping
- Mark sports grounds and erect sports equipment
- Select and use appropriate pesticides
- Prune according to the flowering season
- Manage fine turf and plant trees, shrubs and bedding
- Maintain equipped play areas
- Prepare, excavate and backfill graves
- Complete relevant paperwork

You must make sure that you follow our procedures and Health and Safety rules.

You must remember that you represent the Council in all that you do.

You must speak to customers and colleagues in a helpful and polite way.

Sometimes you will need to attend training sessions or work different hours.

Who is the Person?

It is important to us that you have:

- Experience of tractor and/or ride-on mower driving
- Experience in carrying out grounds maintenance duties
- Ideally hold PA1, PA6 pesticide certification
- Knowledge of plant husbandry, horticultural pests and diseases
- Good plant knowledge and an understanding of fine turf culture
- Knowledge on the selection and use of pesticides
- A mature attitude and able to work without close supervision
- A full valid driving licence
- A nice way of speaking to our customers
- The ability to get on well with your team
- A sense of pride and commitment to do a good job
- Common sense and have good judgement
- The ability to work in all weathers and during occasional evenings and weekends
